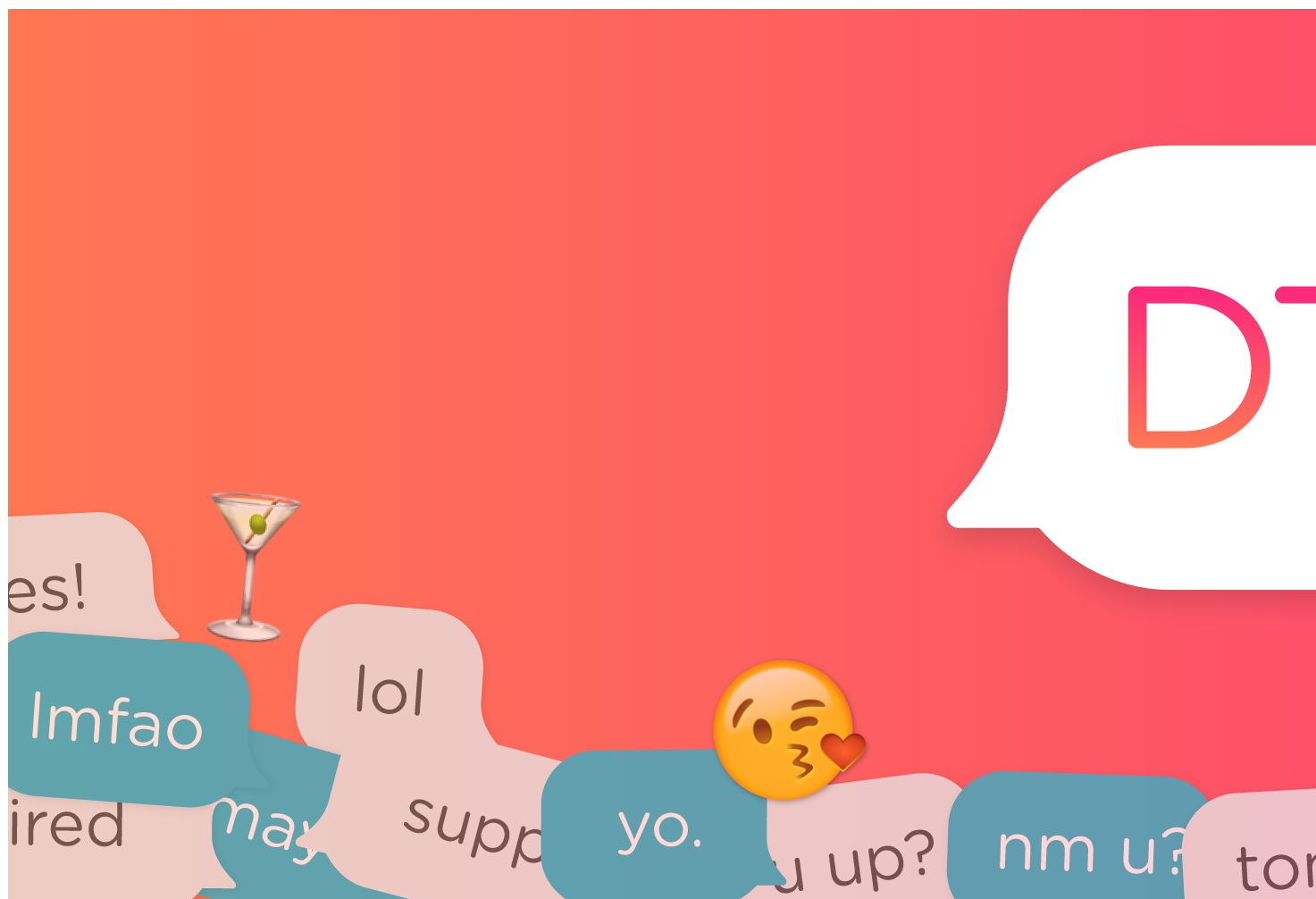


Tinder Hits the Airwaves — New Podcast Tackles Relationships in the Modern World
